November 7 – 18, 2022

Open Enrollment is your once-a-year opportunity to enroll or make changes to your benefits coverage (without having a qualifying life event). During this time, you can:

- **Enroll in, waive or change** your benefits
- **Add or remove** eligible dependents from coverage
- **Opt-in/opt-out** in a health care and/or dependent care flexible spending account (FSA)

This year, if you don't need to enroll, make changes or contribute to an FSA, no action is needed. **Your current benefits will carry over to 2023, except for the FSA.**

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Benefits FAQs

When is Open Enrollment (OE)?
Open Enrollment is the one time during the year that employees may add, change or make changes to their health insurance benefits. **Open Enrollment runs from November 7 - November 18, 2022.**

When do I review my current benefits and make any changes?
Your benefits review begins **Monday at the Workday Open Enrollment site**. Then you'll need to click on the **Open Enrollment** link under the "Announcements" section of your Workday homepage.

Do I need to re-enroll in benefits if I'm not making any changes?
No, this year your **Open Enrollment is passive**. All plans you had for 2022 will automatically carry over unless you elect to make a change.

What happens if I don't re-enroll in my FSA plan (dependent care or health care)?
If you don't re-enroll in your FSA plan, you will lose your FSA funds through March 31, 2023.

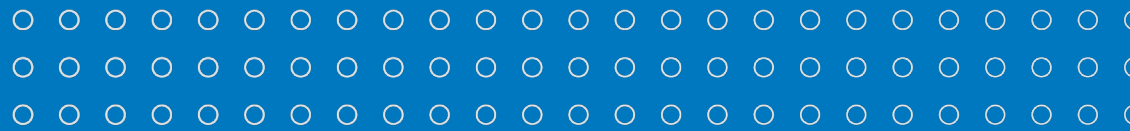
